Use of the frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA Southern Coordinator, Atlanta, Georgia, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (6) Operation is subject to coordination with the Eastern Area Frequency Coordinator located at Patrick AFB, Florida, prior to use within the area bounded by 24 N 31 30'N and 77 W 82 W2.
- (7) Operations on this assignment are subject to immediate cessation, if it causes harmful interference to EPA Coastal OPS Assignments.
