Dear Lorna Finman,

This refers to application, File No. 0216-EX-CN-2017, for an experimental authorization.

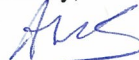
You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. Several issues remain unresolved and there is not enough time to resolve them prior to launch. The unresolved issues are:

The applicant has provided an inadequate EMC analysis for the proposed operations at 144.5 MHz (uplink) and 432.5 MHz (downlink). The applicant did not provide an IARU coordination letter. The analysis consists of a search of a single FCC data base, and fails to analyze possible interference to amateur operations. The site of the single earth station is sufficiently close to Canada that interference to Canadian stations is possible, particularly on the down-link.

We also note that the draft ITU filing should indicate that operations are pursuant to No. 4.4 of the Radio Regulations for the uplink and downlink frequencies. The ITU filing also specifies frequencies that are inconsistent with the license request for the Globalstar radio.
