- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Operation is subject to notification of the following within 100 miles of the test area:
 - Paging Service licensees in 454 MHz/459 MHz.
 - General Aviation Air-Ground Service in 454 MHz/459 MHz
- (5)
 - a) Secure consents from all Advanced Wireless Service licensees within the proposed area prior to accessing to 1710-1850 MHz band.
 - b) Obtain consents from the Broadband Radio Service licensees prior to accessing to 2400-2483 MHz band.
 - c) Coordinate with the local Society of Broadband Engineers frequency coordinator and the Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 2400-2483 MHz
 - d) Coordinate with the local SBE frequency coordinator prior to operation in 420-470 MHz band.
- (6) Operation is subject to coordination prior to activation and, as appropriate, possible scheduling with Paulette Woody, pwoody@nrao.edu, (304) 456-2107, when used within 20 nautical miles of the National Radio Quiet Zone.
- (7) Operations in the band 420-470 MHz under the authority of this license are subject to immediate adjustment, including cessation, if they result in harmful interference to the NASA Firefly satellite system.
- (8) No fixed operations permitted.

Special Conditions:

- (9) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract number W15P7T-10-D-D420 KZO1. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
