Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at http://freq.sbe.org/pdf_files/coordinators.pdf to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (5) Operation is subject to notification of the following within 200 miles of the test area:
 - Paging Service licensees in 454 MHz/459 MHz
 - General Aviation Air-Ground Service in 454 MHz/459 MHz
- (6) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract numbers W911QX-16-C-0012, W15P7T-10-D-D420/0007, and CRN315177W909MY-15-C-0031. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (7) Stop Buzzers are Joe Waddell – (540) 831-0261 and Richard Anderson – (540) 849-9955.
- (8) No fixed operations permitted.
- (9) Operations in the band 420-470 MHz under the authority of this license are subject to immediate adjustment, including cessation, if they result in harmful interference to the NASA Firefly satellite system.
- (10) Operation is subject to coordination prior to activation and, as appropriate, possible scheduling with Paulette Woody, pwoody@nrao.edu, (304) 456-2107, when used within 20 nautical miles of the National Radio Quiet Zone.
