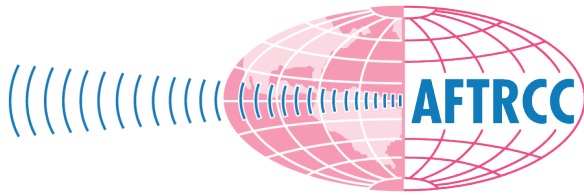

AFTRCC recommends the FCC add the following restriction(s) to the grant of this authorization:

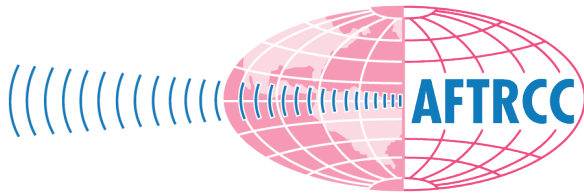
“Experimental use is secondary to, and must not interfere with, Flight Test operations.

***SPECIAL CONDITION: LICENSEE MUST COORDINATE WITH OTHER
USERS AS NECESSARY TO MINIMIZE INTERFERENCE.***

Renewal of this License is subject to prior coordination with AFTRCC Frequency Advisory Committee, www.aftrcc.org”

This coordination letter does not grant the recipient any priority or interference protection with regard to licensees of established radio services. The recipient’s obligations to protect radio stations in the established radio services are set out in the FCC’s rules, including 47 C.F.R. § 5.84 (non-interference criterion and conditions of operation), as well as in any conditions imposed by the FCC on its license.

This coordination letter also does not confer on the recipient, assuming it holds or becomes the recipient of a Part 5 experimental license issued by the FCC, any priority or entitlement to protection with regard to other Part 5 experimental radio station licensees, whether the FCC issues other licensees a Part 5 authorization before or after a grant to the recipient. It is possible that AFTRCC may complete a successful coordination requested by another Part 5 experimental licensee or applicant for all or some of the same frequencies, at the same or a nearby location, and for all or some of the same time period (“apparent conflicting coordination request”). If AFTRCC receives and processes an apparent conflicting coordination request, AFTRCC will endeavor to inform you and the other requestor (or requestors, if more than one) of the apparent conflicting intended uses of the spectrum, so as to provide to you and the requestor(s) the opportunity to develop and implement an arrangement, consistent with your respective coordinations, to cooperatively share the spectrum.



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Irrespective of this coordination letter, recipient may need to cooperate with other Part 5 experimental license recipients, whether recipients of special temporary authority or long-term Part 5 licenses, in order to successfully use and share the spectrum. Recipient may obtain information about other Part 5 experimental license holders and applicants on the FCC's webpage for the Experimental Licensing System, <https://apps.fcc.gov/oetcf/els/reports/GenericSearch.cfm>.

This recommendation is advisory only and not binding on you or the FCC. It does not constitute a judgment that the frequency(ies) specified is/are best suited to your purpose or that the assignment is exclusive to your Company. In utilizing this recommendation, the Company agrees to release and hold harmless AFTRCC, its officers, members, agents, and representatives from and against any claims, losses, damages, or expenses that may arise as a result of your Company's use of the frequency(ies) specified.

This recommendation letter will be valid only for a period of 90 days from the date on this letter. If an application for License has not been filed with the Federal Communications Commission within that period, it will be necessary to request a new frequency recommendation.

The original of this letter should be attached/forwarded to your application for a license when it is filed with the Federal Communications Commission.
