Narrative and Explanation of Operation

This is a request for Special Temporary Authorization for the use of two UHF channels at Circuit of the Americas Motor Speedway near Austin, Texas for the purpose of operational communications at the 24 hour Hankook automobile race event. The event is scheduled to begin on 15 November and end 18 November, 2018.

Requested are the two frequencies 420.43125 MHz and 410.43125 MHz on a duplex basis for voice communications. The system is as configured for European racing venues. It consists of one transmitter in the race car, one temporary base station in the pit area and eleven portable transceivers on this one duplex pair for the mechanics in the pit.

This STA is necessary because the applicant is a European race team with no ability or need to obtain regular licenses for these two channels for this one event in the United States. Frequency coordination has been conducted with ARRL, the national association for Amateur Radio relative to the 420.43125 MHz channel.

Should any reported interference occur, all operation on the applied-for channels will cease immediately and not resume unless and until the interference is resolved to the satisfaction of the complainant licensee.
