On behalf of Lober & Walsh Engineering, Inc. d/b/a Com Dev Wireless ("Com Dev"), this letter respectfully requests expedited treatment of the above-referenced application to perform mobile broadband internet testing in the 1900 MHz Personal Communications Service (PCS) band.

Com Dev wishes to utilize the 1930 MHz - 1990 MHz and 1850 MHz - 1910 MHz PCS C-Block bands currently licensed to Alpine PCS for a 180 day trial which will consist of a two phase mobile multi-site testing plan. Com Dev's tests seek to expand the use of broadband spectrum in the provision of wireless data services.

Alpine PCS has consented to this use of its spectrum as described in the above-referenced application.
