

Lober & Walsh Engineering, Inc., d/b/a Com Dev Wireless (“Applicant”) is currently running two trials under FCC experimental authorization. Applicant anticipates additional trials at a variety of locations. These trials will evolve as the tests proceed and the results are evaluated. As a result, Applicant is requesting a five year nationwide license in order to consolidate its efforts and the minimize the expense and time it takes to continually reapply for location specific licenses and/or renew licenses every two years.

Furthermore, the Applicant is unable to anticipate at this time all of the locations where is will run trials. A nationwide license would enable the Applicant to run trials as the opportunity to run a trial at a new location presents itself. However, Applicant’s intention is to limit its testing to only as many trials as is necessary to properly test the subject equipment, which is approximately 10 different locations.

As mentioned, Applicant currently has two trials underway. One trial has 70 mobile terminals and another trial operating with 150 mobile terminals. Applicant anticipates additional trials running concurrently at separate locations some of which may require as many as 150 mobile terminals at a given location. However, Applicant plans to limit the number of simultaneous trials such that 500 is the maximum number of units Applicant will build any support.
