Hi David,

As you know from my earlier email Lockheed Martin is seeking another STA in order to participate in the Coalition Warrior Interoperability Demonstration (CWID) in the month of June. The CWID is a Joint Chiefs of Staff-directed annual event to demonstrate cutting-edge information technology. The demo will take place in Suffolk, VA and Dahlgren, VA at the Naval Surface Warfare Center.

We have filed the FCC Experimental Special Temporary Authority for the month of June and the File Number is 0208-EX-ST-2009. The FCC has requested that we coordinate with licensees around the test site location. From the FCC records we understand that would include the Spectrum Co LLC license with Call Sign WQGA909. The power levels for the band where there is overlap 2120-2130 MHz is very low 250 mW so we do not expect an interference issues. Of course we understand that our operations are on a non-interference/non-protected basis and if interference were experienced we would shut down our operations. Our point of contacts during the testing are Jordan Thomas, 240-643-5112 or Paul Butterfoss, 814-880-0680. As described in the application the testing is limited in scope and duration.

The FCC has requested a short letter but I believe an email would work as well to notify them that there are no issues with the limited testing Lockheed Martin proposes. We will attach this letter/email as an Exhibit to our experimental STA application.
