This request is to add a new location to the existing station authorization, at **Cazenovia, Onondaga County, NY**, and to modify the frequencies being requested for this location. The program personnel are looking to mirror the testing being done in West Palm Beach, FL at our facilities located in NY.

The changes to the frequencies being requested is to start lower in the 1700 band of frequencies starting at **1708 MHz to 1764 MHz in 8 MHz steps and 1828 MHz to 1980 MHz in 8 MHz steps**. The OTH frequencies being requested in addition to what is already cleared for Florida operations are to include **32.5 to 37.5 MHz**. These are being requested to expand possible test operations, however, if they are not available for assignment the originally assigned frequencies for this authorization will be adequate for the minimal testing to be conducted at the Cazenovia facility.
