I spoke to Claude Wells and he recommended that I contact you directly. The modification to the existing license requests 2700-6000 MHz. This range overlaps existing bands on the license as well as other Aeronautical bands. For example the 2700-2900 MHz band is designated for Aeronautical use. If you need to use the whole range from 2700-6000 MHz then you will need to coordinate with the local FAA office before we can grant your request. Otherwise we will have to dismiss the application.
