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Lockheed Martin MFC-0 has applied for an experimental license at 15, 35 and 94 GHz for use in testing experimental radar waveforms and systems. This license application requests permission to operate anywhere in the continental United States. We have operated and demonstrated our systems in Florida, Michigan, California, Arizona, Nevada, and Virginia, all at military or government installations.

While we often operate at the same locations repeatedly, the nature of our tests often calls us to new locations. This unpredictability makes a continental authorization a requirement for us to operate and collect data effectively. Since our tests are on Military facilities, we always work with the local frequency coordinator to avoid interference.

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
