Dear Mr. Claude Wells:

Please separate the items which are not confidential (frequency band and map) from your confidential description. The non-confidential items at a minimum should be the frequency band and test site locations.

Be aware that the responses to the CFR 47, 0.459b, 1-9, will become public record, therefore, only mention in response #1 your desire to make the emission and bandwidth confidential, then place the actual numerical data in the confidential document (the same is true for the Max RF, Max EIRP and Modulating Signal if you wish to make these confidential as well). Please remove from response #1 the request that the frequency band be kept confidential.

Also, place the words "see attachment" in the Form 442 fields that you wish to make confidential, then include the information that would normally go into those fields in the confidential document.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 10, 2001 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
