John,

This is response to requests for clarification of above referenced STA filings from Lockheed Martin Corporation.

0157-EX-ST-2004 - operations will be conducted at Lewes, DE Coast Guard Station to demonstrate the proposed systems under call sign WC2XWZ. The NAD 83 coordinates supplied by the site personnel are 38° 47' 25" N. and 075° 09' 47" W. The temporary fixed operations will be within a 10 km radius of these coordinates.

0173-EX-ST-2004 - operations conducted at Ft. Drum, NY. These operations will be at a fixed location at Wheeler Sacks Airfield. The mobile radar system will be set up as a fixed operation for the purposes of these tests. It will be operating on the listed frequencies, utilizing the proposed blanking from the FAA.

Please amend the current applications reflecting the above information regarding the proposed operations. 0157-EX-ST-2004 to reflect the temporary fixed area of operations. And 0173-EX-ST-2004 to being only fixed operations at Ft. Drum's Wheeler-Sacks Airfield utilizing the blanking characteristics proposed from the FAA to prebvent interference with Canadian air space.

I hope this clarifies the confusion regarding these applications. And I want to thank you ina advance for any assistance you may provide in the processing of these requests.
