Mr. Charles Peterson,

It appears you are requesting flight testing bounded by a lower limit of 12,000 feet AGL and an upper limit of 29,000 feet MSL within a 300 kilometer radius of Phoenix, AZ (332606N, 1122130W) using the frequency band 227-454 MHz with a maximum bandwidth of 227MQ3N at an output power of 1.45 kW and a peak ERP of 15.723 kW. Is this correct?

If you are requesting multiple locations besides Phoenix, AZ, you must enter those cities (or military bases) and states in the electronic application as separate antennas along with their latitude, longitude and radius of mobile operations.

You must also report a Stop Buzzer point-of-contact, the name and phone number of a person who can cease transmissions immediately at any time should interference occur.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of September 11, 2007 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
