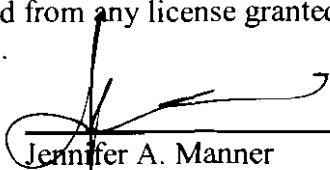

Withdrawal Letter**

Dear Mr. Burtle:

SkyTerra Subsidiary LLC ("SkyTerra"), the licensee of AMSC-1 and SkyTerra 1 (formerly MSV-1), United States satellites licensed by the Commission to provide Mobile Satellite Service ("MSS") in the L band, filed letters with the Office of Engineering and Technology ("OET") on December 16, 2008 and January 21, 2009, requesting the imposition of license conditions on the above-referenced renewal application of Lockheed Martin Corporation ("Applicant"). Applicant seeks, *inter alia*, to transmit on frequencies authorized and operationally in use by SkyTerra's MSS satellite networks.¹ On February 12, 2009, Applicant submitted an email to OET suggesting that it required only the use of the 1670-1800 MHz band for its testing. By excluding the 1640-1660.5 MHz band, which Applicant had originally requested in its application, SkyTerra's expressed interference concerns are now moot. Accordingly, SkyTerra withdraws its request for the imposition of license conditions, subject to the exclusion of the 1640-1660.5 MHz band from any license granted to Applicant. 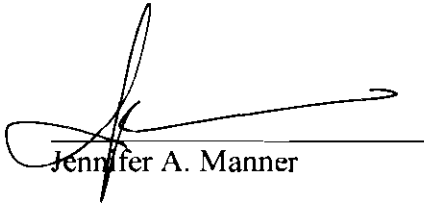
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
