I have received the following message for Rodney Murphy (FAA in the DC area).

The FAA will concur to the use of the five fundamental frequencies requested by Lockheed Martin Missiles and Fire Control under the following conditions:

- The Department of Defense (DOD) concurs with the use of requested frequencies within the military UHF/AM band (225-328.6 MHz)

- The user will follow "cease buzzer" procedures which require the following actions:

 - Advise Air Traffic exactly when transmission will begin and cease.

 - The user will monitor guard frequencies (121.5 MHz and 243.0 MHz).

 - If "cease buzzer is in affect", then they must stop transmissions until the problem is resolved.

The frequency request for 160 MHz (15 MHz bandwidth) should be coordinated thru NTIA, and the request for 195 MHz (bandwidth 20 MHz) does not affect any frequencies used by the FAA.
