Please submit a reliable POC:

A) For **258 MHz** Frequency

- a. Frequency is military JFMO frequency and must be coordinated with FAA prior to transmission.
Prior coordinate with the FAA regional office (Western-Pacific, AWP) and obtain NGT number(s).
- b. The selected emission widths are not authorized for this frequency (32, 200, 42.8 kHz)
The emission widths cannot be greater than 12.5 kHz, please amend the emission widths per MAG specification.

B) For **384 MHz** Frequency

- a. Frequency is allotted for Mexico, if used cannot cause interference to Mexico receivers, and must accept possibility of interference from Mexico.

- b. The selected emission widths are not authorized for this frequency (32, 200, 42.8 kHz)
