In response to correspondence of May 6, we provide the following:

The emission character “X” is not recognizable number. Please replace “X” with a number.

Response: The designators for Ka, Ku, and X-Bands are 1G00GXW, 750MGXW, and 500MGXW respectively. 47 CFR 2.201 of the Commission's rules identifies all permissible emission, modulation, and transmission characteristics. The second character of an emission designator may use "X" to identify the nature of a signal's modulating the main carrier in "cases not otherwise covered" but other options.
