Re: Special Temporary Authorization Request
WC2XWZ Norfolk, VA

We, the Lockheed Martin Corporation, would like to note the following:

- 1) On the new application for WC2XWZ, we need to have item (3) removed, the stipulation for the USCG contract. The overall license is in support of Lockheed Martin activities to perform development and integration of maritime vessel traffic systems, as used by USCG and various international maritime authorities. The reference contract has gone end of life. For instance, we are pursuing a US DHS contract, SBInet, which would involve delivery of maritime X band radars meeting the emission designation, just not the stated USCG contract.
- 2) A very high priority, quick turnaround, effort is to obtain an STA for Norfolk, VA. As noted above, we need the statement removed: "(3) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by US Coast Guard contract number DTCG23-98-R-AVT006 . The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above."

All other operational parameters remain the same.
