First, thanks for your superb follow-up on these applications.

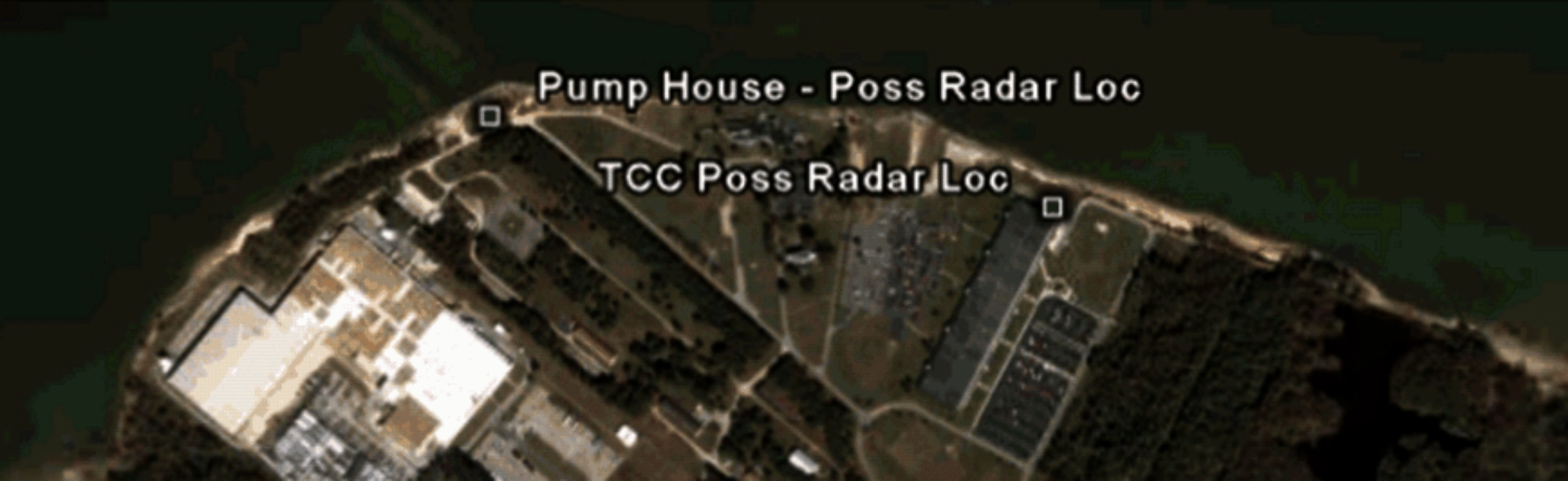
It is entirely understandable that the timing is not sufficient for the low power radar system. I am indeed aware of the lead times, unfortunately a series of items came together due to a demonstration event, and all anyone could do was give it a best effort. Summer holidays exacerbated this. The FCC has done an excellent job, your work is appreciated.

Attached is a GIF showing the location for the FD maritime radar. The physical location is the "Pump House" -- a mechanical facility, with no inhabited area within 200 yards. The antenna is positioned on top of a 40' mast at the pump house. We will, also, be blanking the radar (no emission) shoreward.
