- Strict non interference basis to Flight Test telemetry.
- Positive experimental coordination does not guarantee positive operational coordination.
- Location 1 has conflicting assignments within 10 mile radius and coordination with Bell Helicopter Textron required prior to use.
- Locations 2 & 3 no conflicting assignments within 20 mile radius.
- AFTRCC no longer coordinates the band 2310-2320 MHz on a secondary basis due to LTE deployment by the primary occupant of this band.
