This request is for the renewal and modification of our existing station authorization, **KE2XOR**, currently operating on the radio frequencies 153.15500, 153.18500, 153.221500, 153.23000, 153.24500, 153.27500, 158.28000 and 158.43000 Mhz in the Continental US.

The modification being requested at this time is to combine this authorization with our Special Temporary Authorization **KS2XAL** for operations on Hazeltine Packet Radios operating on the radio frequencies 464.50000, 464.55000 and 469.55000 Mhz, increasing their area of operations to match the area of operations for the existing frequencies. These systems are still operating in accordance to our

existing contract **DAAH01-92-C-R101**, with the Department of Defense. All technical parameters remain unchanged from the previously licensed systems.
