Is this experiment a continuation of the operations under 0383-EX-ST-2005 and 0473-EX-ST-2005 in which an 11.5" antenna is being used for satellite communications on-the-move? If not, briefly explain how these particular satellite communications under 0186-EX-PL-2005 will be used as part of the WIN-T C4ISR system.
