Gentlemen:

General Dynamics, in partnership with Lockheed-Martin, has received a Special Temporary Authorization (STA Call Sign WC9XFU) to transmit to a commercial satellite in the frequency band of 14.00 to 14.50 GHz, from August 19 through 26 in the Taunton, Massachusetts area and from September 6 through December 2 in Ft Huachuca, Arizona area. In accordance with FCC Regulation 47 CFR, parts 101.103(d) and 101.21(f), we are required to notify other licensees in this frequency band, within a 50 km radius, of our intent to transmit.

Should any of your clients experience interference due to our transmissions in this frequency band, please contact the undersigned, and we will immediately cease such operations or adjust such operations to avoid harmful interference.
