Special Conditions:

- (3) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by Navy contract number N00024-00-C-5147. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (4) This frequency assignment on 1030 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the FAA Eastern Coordinator, New York, New York. Use of the frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA Eastern Coordinator, New York, New York, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (5) Use of 1030 MHz is permitted only with PD 0.8 and PRR 370.
- (6) Use of 1090 MHz is permitted only with PD 0.45.
- (7) When using 1090 MHz, any altitude setting must be below sea level or above 60,000 feet.
