- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by State Department contract DP3/4/8/1/2015/52. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.

- (8) Testing operation shall be performed on a strict non-interference basis to stations in Mexico. Lockheed Martin must cease operations immediately upon notification from Area Frequency Coordinators, NTIA or the FCC. Continued future use of the frequencies 138.75 MHz and 142.6 MHz is not anticipated and future requests must comply with the 2007 Mexican Protocol.
- (9) Licensee should be aware that US Air Force and US Marine Corp stations are licensed on these frequencies, and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
