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Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (4) Lockheed Martin Corporation must notch out the 5850-5900.5 MHz, the 2290.0-2290.5 MHz, and the 5600-5650 MHz bands in order to protect vehicle safety communications, space operations, and Air Traffic operations.
- (5) Lockheed Martin Corporation must notch out the following spot frequencies (+/- 8.1 MHz) 2227.5 MHz, 2240.5 MHz, 2248.5 MHz, 2256.5 MHz 2264.5 MHz, and 2273.5 MHz in order to protect ongoing operations in the requested area.
- (6) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract number W15QKN-14-9-1001. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
