Special Conditions:

- (1) Assignment in frequency bands 960-1400, 2700-2900, or 9000-9200 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the FAA Southern Coordinator, Atlanta, GA. Use of frequencies under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA Southern Coordinator, Atlanta, GA, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (2) All operations subject to coordination with the Eastern Area Frequency Coordinator located at Patrick AFB, Florida, prior to use within the area bounded by 24 degrees N, 31 degrees 30' N and 77 degrees W, 83 degrees W.
- (3) All operations subject to coordination with the Gulf Area Frequency Coordinator located at Eglin AFB, Florida, prior to use with the area bounded by 27 degrees N, 33 degrees 30' N; and 83 degrees W, 90 degrees W.
- (4) Operation in the 1710-1755 or 2110-2155 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (5) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (6) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (7) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.

Special Conditions:

- (8) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (9) The licensee shall not constrain or limit the present or future growth of non-Federal and Federal radio services in the area of operation. Furthermore, the licensee shall:
(1.) be responsible for remedying RF interference caused to non-Federal and Federal users including terminating transmissions if necessary to resolve interference, (2.) maintain a transmission log as a standard operating procedure, (3.) periodically check the FCC licensing databases to monitor the authorizations granted in the area of operation, and (4.) notify appropriate the FCC Field Office(s) of the test locations and duration of operation. The Stop Buzzer for this authorization is Robert Reim at (407) 568-7100.
- (10) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract numbers FA8682-10-C-0016 and HR0011-09-C-0096. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
