Narrative Describing Government Project

This license is requested to support a synthetic aperture radar data collection funded by ARPA. The program is under the supervision of Dr. Dominic Giglio, (703) 696-2375. His designated coordinator is Ms. Denise Kellogg, Decision Science Applications, (703) 243-2500.

The project is being funded to collect foliage penetration data in a frequency band (500-800 MHz) where no data currently exists.

Approval was granted in January 1993 for a wider band, higher power Chirp radar to operate over Arizona. The studies done by NTIA, MCEB, SPS, and others should be relevant to this application. The J-12 number is J/F 12/6750/1. A bandwidth extending from 300-924 MHz with a peak power of 600 W was approved for experimental use on a non-interference basis, subject to restrictions.

If the present application is granted, operation is planned for a few weeks over Arizona this fall and for one week this fall or next spring over northeast Maine. The total operating time is not expected to exceed 30 hours in Arizona and 15 hours in Maine. This should help alleviate concerns of radio astronomers.

Other than radio astronomy, the primary potential for interference is UHF television. Informal inquiry indicates there are no UHF transmitters operating in the vicinity of Caribou and Presque Isle, ME, where the data collection is planned. Testing in Arizona can be performed over rural or wilderness areas with the radar antenna pointed away from population centers.

REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED APPROVAL

ARPA personnel need to obtain this radar data before the leaves fall this autumn in the Maine forests, if possible. Therefore an expedited handling of this application is respectfully requested. If an experimental license is granted by September 7, 1993, it will be possible to meet the ARPA schedule objectives.
