5. A. IF ANY SATELLITES ARE NONGEOSTATIONARY, REPORT ITS INCLINATION ANGLE, APOGEE IN KILOMETERS, PERIGEE IN KILOMETERS, ORBITAL PERIOD IN HOURS AND FRACTIONS OF HOURS IN DECIMAL, THE NUMBER OF SATELLITES IN THE SYSTEM
 - a. Inclination is 51.6 degrees
 - b. Period is roughly 92 minutes (so ~1.5 hrs)
 - c. Orbit is about 400km circular (perigee of ~400 and apogee of 405-410).
