Lynk Global, Inc. (Lynk) submits the above referenced application to continue researching and developing its technology to close the digital divide by connecting off-the-shelf cellular devices directly with Low Earth Orbit satellites that will provide cellular service no matter the location of the cellular device. Lynk will launch the satellite described in the above referenced application by the end of July 2021 and requests blanket authority to test cellular devices with the satellite throughout the United States. This request is necessary for Lynk to show its proprietary technology can connect with cellular devices no matter the location.

Lynk has made a formal request for key sensitive information be redacted from the public posting of the application and supporting documents. Pursuant to Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.457 and 0.459, the Commission may withhold from public inspection and accord confidential treatment to certain material related to this application.
