What specific information should be withheld? The attachment titled "SLAMR Experimental Research" in its entirety. It contains nonpublic technical information concerning the SLAMR radar system. 2. In what proceeding was the information submitted? The information was submitted in support of the above-referenced FCC experimental license application. 3. To what degree is the information commercial, financial, privileged, or a trade secret? The attachment contains proprietary engineering, system-design, and operational information constituting confidential commercial information and trade secrets. 4. Does the information concern a service subject to competition? Yes. SLAMR is being developed for competitive radar and defense-technology markets. 5. How could disclosure cause substantial competitive harm? Disclosure could enable competitors to replicate or exploit Accelint's technical approach, reducing its competitive advantage and impairing future business opportunities. 6. What measures prevent unauthorized disclosure? Accelint Intelligence Systems restricts access to personnel and authorized parties with a need to know and protects the information through internal access controls and confidentiality obligations. 7. Is the information publicly available or previously disclosed? No. It is not publicly available and has been disclosed outside Accelint Intelligence Systems only when necessary and subject to confidentiality restrictions. 8. How long should the information remain confidential? Accelint Intelligence Systems requests confidential treatment for five years, because the information is expected to retain commercial value throughout that period. 9. Is there any other relevant information? The public interest will not be impaired by withholding this proprietary technical information because the Commission retains full access for evaluating the application.
