I attempted to amend the ref. application in response to your e-mail (ref. 2212) on-line. There were some items not clearly amended by my submission. Therefore, this e-mail, hopefully, responds to those points.

A second antenna location was added. Emission designators are the same for both locations. In fact, all parameters are the same other than the site and antenna parameters.

Frequency tolerance is 0.0005% for all bands.

The band, 746-806 MHz was added to the frequency list. "MHz" did not appear to go through on-line and, as in the other frequency bands, there would be an entry for both "fixed" and "mobile." The emission designators would be the same as the other bands.

I did not anticipate mean vs. peak power as critical, but would propose "mean" power for analog and "peak" power for digital emissions. The applicant would not object to the specification of "peak" on any frequency where this would expedite action.

I thank you very much for your patience with me and helping to correct items improperly submitted.
