Ladies and Gentlemen:

Magnavox Electronics Systems Company ("Magnavox"), the licensee of the above-referenced Experimental Radio License (the "License"), hereby requests Special Temporary Authority for consummation of the transfer of control of the License from The Carlyle Group, L.P. ("Carlyle") to Hughes Aircraft Company ("Hughes").

On September 22, 1995, Hughes and Carlyle filed with the Commission on FCC Form 703 applications for consent to transfer other experimental, microwave and business radio licenses in connection with the proposed transfer of control of Magnavox from Carlyle to Hughes. Due to a clerical error, however, the License for this experimental radio station was inadvertently omitted from the transfer applications. The parties desire to consummate the transfer of control on or about October 27, 1995. It is therefore unlikely that the FCC Form 703 application, which will be filed as soon as signatures can be obtained from both the licensee and the transferee, will be granted within this narrow timeframe. Accordingly, Magnavox respectfully requests that the Commission grant Special Temporary Authority for the consummation of the transfer of control of the License prior to grant of the Application so that the transfer of control may be consummated in accordance with the scheduled timetable without interruption of service.

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Enclosed is a check made payable to the Federal Communications Commission in the amount of \$45.00 in payment of the requisite filing fee and FCC Form 159 (FCC Remittance Advice).

Magnavox hereby certifies, in accordance with Section 1.2002 of the Commission's Rules, that neither Magnavox nor any other party to this request is subject to a denial of Federal benefits that includes FCC benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 853a.
