1. Are you sure you need an STA? Many devices, especially Part 15 devices, do not need licenses to operate prior to equipment authorization, as long as they are used for certain purposes. Please review Part 2.803 (e) of the FCC's Rules, paying particular attention to subparagraphs 2.803(e)(3)(i)&(ii).

(2) Frequency information is generally not withheld from the public, as this information is necessary to determine possible sources of interference to licensed services. If you still wish to request confidentiality, you must submit an attachment via our electronic filing site that provides all the information required by Part 0.459(b) of the FCC's Rules. Please provide this information organized neatly in the order of the items requested in that rule part so that management may review your request. Please allow extra processing time for the confidentiality request.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of March 25, 2002 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
