- (1) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at http://freq.sbe.org/pdf_files/coordinators.pdf to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Testing operations in the 2085.0275-2086.3475 MHz frequency band or while using a frequency of 2085.6875 MHz shall not occur when the NASA International Space Station (ISS) (NORAD designation 25544 or international spacecraft ID 1998-067A) is within the horizon to horizon view of the Marris Developments facility in Boardman, OR.
- (5) All testing operations shall be coordinated with the NASA GSFC Spectrum Manager, Scott Galbraith at 301-286-5089 or vincent.s.galbraith@nasa.gov, at least 7 days in advance of operation. This includes providing detailed test procedures and a specific schedule of planned testing events.
