On June 28, 2001, MDS America filed a revised Phase I Test Plan for MDS America's Clewiston, Florida area experimental testing, pursuant to paragraph 11 of MDS America's Experimental license No. 0095-EX-PL-2001. The June 28 Test Plan runs from July 5 to July 12, 2001. MDS America would now like to supplement that Test Plan with testing on one additional day, July 13, 2001. Transmission times on July 13 will be intermittent from 8:00 to 19:00.

Pursuant to the June 28, 2001 revised Test Plan, MDS America also wishes to report that on July 5, 2001 the transmitter was scheduled to be turned off at 18:00, but was not turned off until 19:20. The reason is that the transmitter is located in a building owned by the United States Sugar Corporation, which requested that the building be locked when no one from MDS America was in it. The MDS America team member at the transmitter site had left (and locked) the building to inspect the tower located behind it, and when he returned, he found that the key he had been given did not work. Despite continuous, repeated attempts, entry to the building could not be achieved until 19:20, at which time the transmitter was turned off. As a result of this experience, from now on an MDS America team member will be in the building at all times when the transmitter is on.

The above information was also provided to Mr. James Burtle, Chief of the Experimental Licensing Branch in a telephone conversation today.

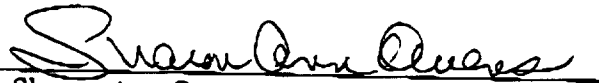
