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Message:

We have two different sets of products, using two different radio technologies, being developed by different groups. Which may or may not be evaluated in concurrent studies at the same locations.

It was believed by Medtronic that it would lessen confusion by operating under two separate experimental licenses, one type radio under file No. 0017-EX-ML-2014, and another under file No. 0096-EX-PL-2014. It is now apparent that confusion has not been avoided.

In addition, we had already submitted 0017-EX-ML-2014 when we realized WF2XFZ (file no. 0409-EX-RR-2011) had expired as of January 1, 2014. The technical data from our old WF2XFZ license was modified/updated and submitted as a new license application file no. 0096-EX-PL--2014, rather than attempting to add it to our 0017-EX-ML-2014 submission, or renew an expired license.

Please advise as to the Commission's preference should you desire a change.
