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SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION

MeshNetworks, Inc., respectfully seeks a correction to Condition No. 5 associated with the above-referenced license.

The license as initially issued in 2001 authorized the company to conduct experimental operations in the bands 2.4-2.4835 GHz and 5725-5875 MHz allocated for equipment authorized under Part 15 of the Commission's rules. The company indicated in the application it submitted at that time that the power levels for the experimental operation would not exceed those authorized under Part 15. Accordingly, the FCC placed the following condition on the initial license:

(5) Operating powers must comply with the limits authorized under Part 15 of the FCC rules.

In 2003, the company submitted an application to modify the license to add the bands 4.940 – 4.990 GHz and 5.850 – 5.925 GHz allocated under Part 90 of the FCC's rules and which are not subject to the power limitations set forth under Part 15. See File No. 0079-EX-ML-2003. As a result, the license as modified by the FCC specifies that the effective radiated power (ERP) for those additional bands are 16 watts and 30 watts, respectfully. Condition No. 5, however, was not changed to reflect that it applied only to the Part 15 bands.

Accordingly, the company respectfully asks the FCC to change the condition on the license, upon renewal, to state as follows:

(5) Operating powers in the 2.4-2.4835 GHz and 5725-5875 MHz bands must comply with the limits authorized under Part 15 of the FCC rules.
