Please consider this our fee exemption explanation for the license holder of WF2XZS being classified as a government entity . Listed please find the justification of such:

Miami-Dade County is the holder of OET license WF2XZS; a government entity. This license is used to operate in the PSST's 700 MHz band spectrum to demonstrate Long Term Evolution ("LTE") equipment in Miami, Florida. It is used for LTE testing operations as a value of a network to first responders, in anticipation of the national public safety broadband network governed by the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet). This service greatly benefits public safety and Miami-Dade County through a number of functions. This not only supports public safety functions, but also supports the citizens of Miami-Dade County.

The system is managed and operated by Miami-Dade County, a government entity. As a government entity, we respectfully request our application to be considered fee exempt.
