This application is actually for reinstatement of a license that lapsed this past June that has been operating since 1982, KM2XJN. The applicant is an equipment manufacturer that demonstrates their equipment to prospective buyers throughout the country. The original application and each modification were coordinated with the bureaus each time. Now, realizing that allocations may have changed during this long period, you have every right to re-review it at this time. We have previously limited the license with the following condition: "The output power and channels shall be restricted not to exceed the limits specified in FCC Rule Parts 21, 74, 78, 90 and 94," and would add "Operation is subject to prior coordination with the Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE); ATTN: Executive Director; 8445 Keystone Crossing, Suite 140; Indianapolis, IN 46240-2454; Phone, (317) 253-1640; FAX, (317) 253-0418; E-mail, executivedir@sbe.org," and other similar conditions, i.e., Part 25 and Part 101 coordination requirements. If you can suggest conditions or suggest band deletions that would allow you to concur with a grant of this application, we would gladly take them.
