Special Conditions:

- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Mimosa Networks coordinate with the existing and future Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).
- (5) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (6) Licensee must avoid pointing the main beam transmitting antenna within 15 degrees of any point on the geostationary orbit arc in the 5850 – 6400 MHz band.
