 - o Paging services in 152, MHz, 158 MHz and, 152 MHz/158 MHz
- (5) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local SBE frequency coordinator prior to operation in 139-225 MHz band.
- (6) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract numbers FA8721-05-C-0002, and FA8702-15-D-0001. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
