Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) To avoid harmful interference to receiving space stations in the Mobile-Satellite Service (MSS) using Non-Geostationary Satellite Orbits (NGSO) in the frequency range 29.1 - 29.5 GHz, sufficient angular separation shall be maintained between the experimental transmitting station and NGSO MSS space stations.
- (3) This license corrects the power level and supersedes any previous license for this call sign.
