Mr. Kennedy,

This is to follow up your voicemail question regarding the need for a 5-year license.

Motorola requires a 5-year license to test, demonstrate and operate prototype equipment in connection with a U.S. government contract that will require it to engage in such activities over the course of the next 5 years and possibly longer. Motorola will seek renewal of its experimental license if necessary. Moreover, as mentioned in the narrative, Motorola is continually developing equipment for public safety use and seeks to test and demonstrate equipment during various stages of design and development to evaluate its functionality, acceptability, and interoperability prior to seeking equipment authorization. Grant of a 5-year license will serve the public interest, necessity and convenience, as it will allow Motorola to continue to improve upon equipment over the course of the extended license period to meet public safety needs.
