The memo provides the justification of the need for an experimental license. This experimental license is filed instead of an Equipment Authorization Filing due to changes which may be made while testing fixed and mobile products still in developmental phases. Many different products may operate on this license; however, all operate within the given frequency limits. As for nationwide authority, these products may be used for demonstration purposes at trade shows, customer sites, or other locations. This type of blanket license allows us to test and demonstrate products nationwide without applying for a specific license for each individual product.
