In accordance with the authority granted by the above-referenced experimental license, WB2XCJ, File No. 0126-EX-RR-2005, this is to notify the Commission of Motorola's intent to conduct a test under the parameters of its license (attached). Pursuant to Special Condition (9) of the license, this notification is being electronically submitted and provides pertinent technical information for the intended test as follows:

Motorola has coordinated this test with co-channel licensees operating within the potential reception range, in accordance with Section 101.103(d) of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 101.103(d)(2005) as set forth in Special Condition (10) of the license. Motorola has also copied UTAM, Inc., on this notification, in accordance with the FCC's Public Notice, "*Experimental Licenses in the 1910 - 1930 MHz Band*" 1996 FCC LEXIS 1053 (rel. Mar. 1, 1996) and will operate in compliance with the power limitations and other FCC rules and regulations governing operations in this band applicable to low power, unlicensed personal communications service devices. *See id.* at §§1.1307(b), 2.1091, 2.1093 and § 15.301 *et seq.* In addition, Motorola will have the capability to disable the equipment remotely from its 24-hour system support center in the unlikely event that doing so becomes necessary.

Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.

Special Conditions:

- (3) Any operation in these bands must be coordinated with the existing and future users to avoid interference. Emission types may vary under the experiment.
- (4) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (5) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (6) Operation in the 824-849 or 869-894 MHz band requires consent of local cellular licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (7) NO market studies may be conducted under this authorization without further approval.
- (8) Licensee is authorized to operate up to 10 base stations and 200 mobile units for each individual experiment. Licensee shall not operate more than 50 base stations and 750 mobiles for all experiments combined under this authorization. Operation of additional base stations and mobile units must be requested with sufficient justification.
- (9) Licensee is authorized under Section 5.75 to test, demonstrate and operate prototype products in the above frequency bands. Licensee is required to notify the Commission of the specific details of each individual experiment, including location, number of base and mobile units, power, emission designator, and any other pertinent technical information. No operation shall take place until the Commission has received the required notification. This notification should be uploaded electronically via the OET Experimental Licensing Branch's Electronic Filing Web Site at https://gulfoss2.fcc.gov/prod/oet/index_els.html using the "Add Attachments" feature.
- (10) Operation in the band 1910-1930 MHz is subject to prior coordination with existing and future fixed microwave service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).
