RE: Special Temporary Authority (STA)

Motorola is requesting an STA per FCC Rule Section 5.56. The intent of this STA is to conduct experiments pertaining to the on air testing of our iDEN 900 MHz system.

Motorola is in the process of filing a modification to our experimental authorization under call sign KI2XCF to add frequency band 806-822/851-867. Due to a change in our customer requirements and contract agreements it is imperative that we begin testing immediately. If it is necessary to wait the prescribed time for a license modification to grant, software release dates will slip well past these requirements. We are requesting this STA to begin testing while our FCC Form 442 is being processed.
