**REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT
AND COORDINATION**

As discussed in the accompanying "Narrative Statement," Motorola is actively involved in the research and development of hardware and software solutions for the public safety and homeland security community and is continually engaged in the design and development of a new and innovative communications equipment. The experimental authority requested in its application will allow the company to demonstrate the performance and functionality of prototype broadband Long-Term Evolution ("LTE") devices to persons involved in public safety and homeland security activities.

Motorola was finally advised only a few days ago that it is expected to conduct demonstrations at the Motorola Data Users Group ("MDUG") conference to be held November 5-12, 2010, at the Red Rock Casino Resort Spa in Las Vegas, Nevada. In preparation for that demonstration, Motorola must conduct preliminary tests, commencing November 5, 2010. Accordingly, Motorola respectfully requests expedited treatment of its request for special temporary authority ("STA") so that it may conduct preliminary tests in a timely fashion.

Motorola submits that expedited processing of its request for an STA is in the public interest, convenience, and necessity, as it will permit Motorola to develop innovative equipment that will accommodate the communications needs of the public safety and homeland security community and, ultimately, the public.
